- Tonight's drawing will be the 43rd drawing in the jackpot run a new game record for most consecutive drawings in a jackpot cycle.
- There were seven winning tickets worth \$1 million or more in last Saturday's drawing:
 - Match 5: California, Florida, Michigan, New Jersey, Virginia
 - Match 5 + Power Play[®]: North Carolina, Pennsylvania
- \$500,000 Double Play[®] winners in Colorado and North Carolina
 - More than 200,000 tickets won prizes in last Saturday's Double Play drawing.
 - Double Play is a \$1 add-on that allows players to play their numbers, again, in a separate drawing for a chance to win up to \$10 million.
- This is the second Powerball jackpot to reach \$1 billion this year, following the \$1.787 billion jackpot won on Sept. 6 in Missouri and Texas.
- The current jackpot run has produced 59 *Match 5* winners (\$1 million) and ten *Match 5* + *Power Play* (\$2 million).
- How is the Powerball Grand Prize estimate determined?
 The two main factors that determine the advertised jackpot annuity are projected ticket sales and the annuity factor. The annuity factor, or cost to fund an annuity

prize, is made up of interest rates for securities purchased to fund prize payments. Higher interest rates allow for the purchase of a larger annuitized prize.

• Do I have less of a chance to win, if more people are playing?

No, Powerball players have the same chance to win in every Powerball drawing, regardless of how many tickets are sold or how big the jackpot grows.

- The overall odds of winning a prize are 1 in 24.9.
- The odds of winning the jackpot are 1 in 292.2 million.

\$2 Ticket Price

- Powerball has had a \$2 ticket price since 2012.
- The current game matrix and odds have been in place since 2015.
- **Good Causes** On average, 35% of a \$2 Powerball ticket goes to fund good causes; transfer percentages vary by jurisdiction.
- Annuity vs. Cash Powerball jackpot winners may choose to receive their prize
 as an annuity or a lump sum payment (cash option). Both advertised prize
 options are prior to federal and jurisdictional taxes. A jackpot winner who selects
 the annuity will receive one immediate payment followed by 29 annual payments
 that increase by 5% each year.

- o Apr 26, 2025 \$167.3 million Kentucky
- o May 31, 2025 \$204.5 million California
